There are 16 one-day and 3 two-day events throughout the season. Players can play in any number of events and there is a season-long Order of Merit points race in which your best 7 of 19 events count.

TOUR REGISTRATION

Just visit the website www.gtaamateurtour.com to sign up for The Tour. If you do not currently have an accredited RCGA handicap don't worry - we can help you to set one up. We use your handicap to put you into one of 4 Flights and you then play stroke play against all of the other players in your Flight.

The current Tour registration fee is \$155. For the first 400 players this fee includes the following which is valued at over \$350:

PRIZING

At the 14 regular season events the retail value of the per Flight prizing will be \$500 – 1st, \$250 – 2nd, \$125 – 3rd and \$75 – 4th. Prizing and points will be increased by 50% for the 3 majors and by 100% for the Tour Championship.

EVENT REGISTRATION FLEXIBILITY

One week prior to the event tee times are both emailed to players and posted on the website. Players also have the ability to make specific tee time requests at least 8 days prior to each event. The Tour Team will make every effort to accommodate scheduling and carpooling requests.
